Attractive, fruity, toasty, tropical aromas and flavors of pineapple upside down cake, apple pie, young coconut, and mango and papaya relish with a satiny, bright, fruity medium-to-full body and an interesting, medium-long green apples, pickled melon, and nougat finish with fine, fruit tannins and a suggestion of oak. A rich, savory chardonnay for all occasions.”

A rich, chewy Napa cabernet that is sure to please.”
