## VINTAGE SUMMARY

Though 2014 brought the earliest harvest since 2004 in the Napa Valley, and a week earlier than 2013, the vintage is viewed as comparable to the highly touted 2012 vintage. Though growers were concerned about drought conditions, rain came at just the right time during the growing season. Despite the negative impacts of the earthquake it did cause seasonal creeks to release water, supplying water to wine grape roots.

## WINEMAKING NOTES

Fermented and aged in 100% neutral French oak barrels.

## SENSORY

A gorgeous deep colored Rosé, with the quintessential red fruit aromas of the Syrah grapes. Red fruit carries through on the palate, giving way to a slight impression of sweetness from the intense fruit despite the dry nature of the wine. On the palate, the wine has the weight and body of a light red ending with a refreshing dry finish and is a perfect winter or Summer Rosé.
